“Reading in the Content Areas with Research-Based CRISS Strategies,” produced by School Improvement Network (SINET) is a three part video series which features Project CRISS. Parts 1 and 2 show excerpts from a Level I CRISS training facilitated by Dr. Carol M. Santa, the original developer of Project CRISS. In addition, these parts include interviews with teachers, administrators, and parents relating their experiences with CRISS and video clips which illustrate how the various CRISS principles and strategies are implemented in actual classrooms. Parts 1 and 2 are available in both elementary and secondary versions.

Part 3 of the video series, Leadership Program, provides guidance to administrators and CRISS implementation teams in ways to develop a three-year implementation plan and to conduct classroom walk-throughs to assess the quality of implementation. SINET publishes the videos in a variety of formats including video tapes, DVDs, and CD-ROMS. Parts 1 and 2 in CD-ROM format are included with the *CRISS Cornerstones* follow-up materials.
