



*CRISS Kudos* go to **Canyon View High School** in Cedar City, Utah. We just heard from one of our CRISS trainers in Utah that the students at this school had significant gains in their SAT and ACT scores. The complete battery test of the SAT (Stanford Achievement Test) results showed a **7% gain** from the academic year 2001-2002 to the year 2002-2003.

Vicki Wilson, the principal at Canyon View, attributed the gain to Project CRISS. She further stated their school had made no changes in their curriculum and had not used any new programs other than CRISS. The students showed an even greater **increase, 10%, in their reading scores on the same test** which raised the overall test results dramatically. In addition, Canyon View has had a steady increase in student attendance since implementing Project CRISS. We would like to congratulate the administration, staff, and students at Canyon View High School, in Cedar City, for the significant improvement in their test scores!
